NCPD provides (arch)dioceses across the nation with disability resources, training, and support to advance the full participation of persons with disabilities in the life of the Church.

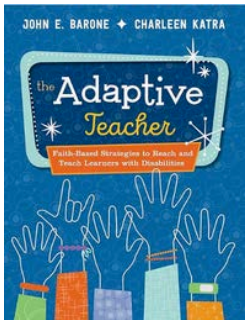


Adapted Faith Formation
